RESOLUTION NO. 2022-33

WHEREAS, the California Department of Social Services (“CDSS”) has made funds available to establish, continue, and expand housing and homelessness assistance and prevention through the Bringing Families Home (“BFH”) Program; and

WHEREAS, the BFH Program provides housing supports to families receiving child welfare services who are experiencing homelessness or at risk of homelessness or in a living situation that cannot accommodate a child or multiple children in the home, thereby increasing family reunification and preventing foster care placement; and

WHEREAS, the Budget Act of 2021 (Senate Bill 129, Chapter 69, Statutes of 2021) appropriated a total of \$92.5 million for BFH in Fiscal Year (“FY”) 2021-22 to be available for expenditure July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, the CDSS has Noncompetitive Allocation funding available for all fifty-eight (58) counties and one continuing tribe in an amount based on a local need methodology. Grantees must sign and submit a Director’s Certification to accept these funds, which do not have a match requirement and must be expended by June 30, 2024; and

WHEREAS, Noncompetitive Allocation funding not accepted by way of a completed Director’s Certification, including funds declined by a grantee will be allocated to grantees that indicate they can accept additional funds, as indicated in the Director’s Certification; and

WHEREAS, the CDSS has allocated \$700,000 of BFH FY 2021-22 Noncompetitive Allocation funding to Yuba County; and

WHEREAS, the HHSD Director seeks to submit a Director's Certification to accept Yuba County's BFH FY 2021-22 Noncompetitive Allocation funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors that the HHSD Director is authorized to submit a Director's Certification for Yuba County's BFH FY 2021-22 Noncompetitive Allocation funding and any subsequent funds allocated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Yuba County Board of Supervisors that the HHSD Director is authorized to: execute, subject to review and approval of County Counsel, all documents as required by the Certifications and the resultant allocations for the term of July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2024 including subsequently extended term; execute agreements, memorandums of understanding (MOUs) or amendments developed under BFH, including but not limited to amendments for additional or lesser funding; and accept, transfer and allocate all BFH funds and any subsequent funds allocated for the stated period.

A copy of the executed agreement, MOU or any amendment thereto shall be filed in the office of the Clerk of the Board.


