RESOLUTION NO. 2022-166

WHEREAS, Title 3, Division 3, Chapter 2, Article 2, commencing with section 29320 of the California Government Code authorizes the Board of Supervisors to establish a revolving cash fund for the use of any officer of the County; and

WHEREAS, Section 873(b) of the California Welfare and Institutions Code provides for the creation of a Ward Welfare Fund; and

WHEREAS, Section 873(d) of the California Welfare and Institutions Code provides that any money, refund, rebate, or commission received from a telephone company or pay telephone provider when the money, refund, rebate, or commission is attributable to the use of pay telephones which are primarily used by confined wards or detainees while incarcerated shall be deposited in the Ward Welfare Fund; and

WHEREAS, Section 873(e) of the California Welfare and Institutions Code grants authority to the chief probation officer to expend the money and property deposited in the Ward Welfare Fund for the benefit, education, and welfare of the wards and detainees confined within the juvenile hall or other county juvenile facilities; and

WHEREAS, Section 873(h) of the California Welfare and Institutions Code grants authority to the chief probation officer to expend money from the Ward Welfare Fund to provide indigent wards and detainees, prior to release from the juvenile hall, any county juvenile facility, or other juvenile detention facility under the jurisdiction of the chief probation officer, with essential clothing and transportation expenses within the county or, at the discretion of the chief probation officer, transportation to the minor's county of residence, if the county is within the state or 500 miles from the county of incarceration. This subdivision does not authorize expenditure of

money from the Ward Welfare Fund for the transfer of any ward or detainees to the custody of any other law enforcement official or jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, a revolving cash fund is essential for the purchase of youth program expenses for field trips, special program activities, holiday activities, program incentives, awards and needs of indigent wards and detainees; and

WHEREAS, the chief probation officer requests that a revolving cash fund be established to make purchases for the benefit, education, and welfare of the wards and detainees confined within the juvenile hall or other county juvenile facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the establishment of a revolving cash fund available to the Probation Department not to exceed two-hundred fifty dollars (\$250.00). The revolving cash fund shall be administered according to and subject to the conditions set forth in Government Code sections 29320, et seq.




