**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-189**

**WHEREAS**, the Three Rivers Levee Improvement Agency (TRLIA) identified and successfully carried out four phases of work along the Yuba, Feather, and Bear Rivers, and the Western Pacific Interceptor Canal in order to achieve the goal of 200-year flood protection for the communities of Linda, Olivehurst, Arboga, and Plumas Lake; and

**WHEREAS**, the four phases of work entailed an investment of more than \$500 million by the State of California and Yuba County residents; and

**WHEREAS**, SB 5 (2007) requires that land use agencies make certain findings associated with 200-year flood protection when they enter into development agreements, approve discretionary permits, or approve tentative maps for properties located in flood hazard areas; and

**WHEREAS**, TRLIA has certified that 200-year protection exists for South Yuba County and has provided the substantial evidence the County of Yuba needs to make SB 5 findings; and

**WHEREAS**, TRLIA and its consultants have prepared an Engineer's Report that documents compliance with the Urban Levee Design Criteria (ULDC), which is available at [www.trlia.org](http://www.trlia.org); and

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**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Yuba County Board of Supervisors hereby certifies the finding of 200-year flood protection for South Yuba County through fulfillment of the Urban Levee Design Criteria, as documented in the Engineer's Report attached as Exhibit A.




