## Yuba County Code Enforcement

(Vehicle Abatement, Parking and Storage)





## Prohibited Actions

- Do not block sidewalk or driveway
- Do not store or park vehicles in the right-of-way for longer than 72 hours.
- Automobile repair is prohibited in residential areas. Refer to YCOC 7.35.030 for exceptions.
- Recreational vehicles, trailers and boats, may not be parked or stored in the public right-of-way.
- Do not park vehicles on lawn.
- Commercial vehicles may not be parked in residential areas.
- Do not live in or allow anyone else to live in a travel trailer or RV on your property.



Code Enforcement's goal is to eliminate environments that create or support public health or safety hazards as well as promote a minimum standard of living. Our hope is that our efforts will enhance the enjoyment of people who live, work and visit within our communities. We have observed a growing number of vehicles, boats, trailers and RV's that may be in violation of the county ordinance and would like to provide you brief information on what our initial steps may be when handling these types of violations. When a determination has been



made that a vehicle constitutes a public nuisance, initial action will be an attempt to achieve voluntary compliance.



If voluntary compliance is not achieved, enforcement actions may be elevated at the expense of the registered owner and/or property owner. Attempts to achieve voluntary compliance may be by means of a 72 hour WARNING tag attached to the vehicle in violation of the Yuba County Ordinance Code, or a door hanger attached to your front door. If you receive one of the above mentioned warnings, please correct the violation immediately. If you need assistance contact Yuba County Code Enforcement (see reverse for contact information).



## How You Can to Help

- Park in designated parking areas only
- Learn and adhere to county ordinances and California state laws pertaining to vehicles. The Yuba County Ordinance Code can be located at [www.yuba.org](http://www.yuba.org).
- Store recreational vehicles, all trailers and boats in proper storage facility.
- Keep all vehicles registered and in working condition.
- Report violations and nuisances
- Cooperate in good faith should you receive a visit from Code Enforcement
