### Viewing Your Voter Participation History:

Select an election from the dropdown menu. Ballot status will display for that election.

#### Voting History

If you voted in an election, you can see if you voted at a polling place, vote center, voted by mail, or cast a provisional ballot.

If you do not see a recent election that you voted in, it may be because your county has not yet sent information about your ballot to the Secretary of State.

Counties have up to 60 days after the election to provide this information to the Secretary of State.

Please note that any voting history prior to the November 6, 2016, General Election is not displayed on this website.
