About the Program . . .

The Yuba County Sheriff's Department is dedicated to establishing and maintaining a safe community. The Cadet Program is an extension of that philosophy. It is through this program we can educate and encourage young adults who are interested in a career in the criminal justice system.

Training and Experience. . .

New Cadets must complete 56 hours of training, including:

- Patrol Techniques
- Laws of Arrest
- Criminal Law
- Radio Procedures
- Ethics
- Jail Procedures
- Records and Communications
- Defensive Tactics/Handcuffing

Cadets are volunteers and are not paid for their time. Cadets may work on patrol, in the dispatch center, the jail, or on special projects and other community events.

Opportunities . . .

The Cadet Program offers an excellent opportunity for those interested in a career in law enforcement to gain first-hand knowledge and experience.

Cadets have the opportunity to advance in rank and responsibility. Future status with the department can be greatly enhanced through your performance in this program.

Let Us Help You Begin A Career In Law Enforcement

Cadets are required to purchase their own uniforms. The estimated cost is \$200-\$300. Badges, leather gear, radios, ballistic vests and other related equipment is provided by the Department.

Qualifications . . .

- **AGE:** Applicants must be 16 to 21 years old at the time of application.
- **EDUCATION:** Cadets must possess a high school diploma, or GED equivalent, or be currently enrolled in high school. Cadets currently enrolled in high school or college must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.
- **PHYSICAL CONDITION:** Cadets must be in good physical condition.
- **MORAL CHARACTER:** Cadets must conform to the high ethical standards of the law enforcement profession. Cadets may not have a prior felony conviction.
- **COMMITMENT:** Cadets must donate a minimum of 16 hours each month. They are expected to attend monthly meetings and training.
